

## Transparent, secure and correct results!

## Chalenge:

iVote Technologies' team under the subcontracting agreement with the partner Scytl from Spain worked on the General elections in Bosnia and Herzegovina that were held in 2010. The assignment there was not an easy job. The development of an IT system was a complex process. The fact that BiH is divided in cantons and the multinational character of the country made it very attention demanding and long process. iVote Technologies' team not only provided support from the start – but also had representatives there for support, for three months during the whole process.

## **Solution:**

The result of this work is BiH IIES (Bosnia and Herzegovina – Integrated Information Election System) - a system that enables automatic evaluation of the results from the election process for all the types of election processes (8 – general and municipal) in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

The B-Vote software performs changes to voting options in the Central Voters' Register (hereinafter referred to as CVR) and to the records of contact information on BiH citizens voting outside BiH. It also allows for entering refugees onto the Central Voters' Register and into the records of contact information on BiH citizens voting outside BiH. It allows for keeping records of rejected applications with rationales, in addition to the records of the BiH citizens whose applications were rejected.

## Success:

It was the IVote's team that helped in the accomplishment of the objective of the BiH IIES - to allow **transparent**, **secure and correct results for the local elections**.
