Client: *The Human and Institutional Development Program (HIDP)- USAID funded program, implemented by World Learning, on behalf on the Association of Journalists of Macedonia (AJM).*

Industry: *Public Sector*

Challenge:

In July 2009 as part of its activities, HIDP hired IVote Technologies' consultants to conduct assessment of the AJM IT infrastructure. The assessment was conducted using interviews and onsite scanning of the available equipment and its configuration. The scope of assessment was the complete IT infrastructure, which included the network configuration, network hardware, computer hardware and software applications used by the employees.

Solution:

Focusing on the improvement of the IT infrastructure of the Association, the experts used systematic approach to identify the IT infrastructure gaps (i.e., the problems), and a mix of recommendations on specific solutions - both hardware and software - to close those gaps.
